DAY ONE

Outdoor Adventure

Hiking, hang gliding, mountain biking, white-water rafting, legendary golf—outdoor adventures abound among Georgia's diverse and beautiful landscapes. Soar 70 feet above the terrain on a steel cable during the thrilling new North Georgia Canopy Tour (northgeorgiacanopytours.com). Or join the wildlife at the Okefenokee Swamp, where you can canoe with alligators at Stephen C. Foster State Park (gastateparks.org/scfoster).

DAY TWO

Wineries

Georgia vineyard acreage has more than tripled in five years. Wineries provide tours and tastings of award-winning wines across the state—especially in the Northeast Georgia Mountains (georgiawine.com). In Dahlonega alone, you can sip your way through Wolf Mountain Vineyards and Winery, BlackStock Vineyards and Winery, Frogtown Cellars, and Three Sisters Vineyard. In Statesboro, Meinhardt Vineyards & Winery (meinhardtvineyards.com) has become Southeast Georgia's first winery.

DAY THREE

Antebellum Trail

View both white-columned mansions and humbler architectural statements in Madison, Watkinsonville, and Eatonton, and in Macon's 11 historic districts. Tour the Old Governor's Mansion in Milledgeville, see why Athens' double-barreled cannon was a bad idea, and explore the

New England-style village of Old Clinton (near Gray). The annual Antebellum Pilgrimage (April 27–May 1, 2011) includes stunning private homes; antebellumtrail.org.

DAY FOUR

Georgia's Coast

Georgia's 100-mile coast encompasses deserted beaches, the soulful Gullah-Geechee culture, and fabulous low-country seafood. In Brunswick, shrimp boats line the waterfront, and the nearby Golden Isles—St. Simons, Little St. Simons, Sea, and Jekyll islands—offer natural attractions, great golf, and the luxurious Cloister at Sea Island (bgjvb.com). Ever-gracious Savannah boasts the newly renovated Broughton Street shopping district, and nearby Tybee Island supplies beach fun (visitsavannah.com).

DAY FIVE

Atlanta CityPASS

Atlanta CityPASS gets you deep discounts for world-class attractions. Tickets cover Georgia Aquarium, the World of Coca-Cola, Zoo Atlanta, and the Inside CNN Studio Tour, plus a nature option (Fernbank Museum of Natural History or the Atlanta Botanical Garden) and a museum option (the High Museum of Art or the Atlanta History Center). Cost is \$74 for adults, \$54 for children ages 3–12, for savings of \$74 and \$54, respectively, over regular admission prices; www.citypass.com/atlanta.
